Pastoral musicians and everyone interested in hymnody will find the analysis of over fifty hymns interesting. Those who work professionally in church music—publishers, directors of music ministry, organists, and choir directors—will find the commentary on the hymns a form of meditation, bringing texts to life that may have grown stale by repetition. For the pastor and parish who have become discouraged in making the effort at congregational singing, The Song of the Singing Assembly will serve as a reminder about the importance of hymn singing, not just for the liturgy, but the for life of the parish. 

Most of the tunes found in *Known Unknowns* will be well known to people who have some familiarity with hymns and folk songs.

The unknown factor is the texts. Some have appeared in previous lona publications to known tunes; some to dedicated, original tunes. Almost fifty percent of the texts in *Known Unknowns* have never appeared in a hymnal or song book. The texts represent a wide gamut of subject matter, from psalm paraphrases to songs about ecology, abuse, money, depression, and delight. They are intended for churches where there is no musician, churches where there is a reticence to sing new songs, or churches where the praise of God has been kept separate from the concerns of the world.

Several indexes are provided, including by tune and by topic; the vast majority of the tunes can be found in any hymnal, while the topical index should be helpful when looking for songs to suit a particular theme in the readings or liturgy.


