

Other Hymn Publications

Between 1951 and 1970 The Hymn Society published five other collections and one individual hymn in addition to the booklets of hymns generated by searches.

- 1951 *The Lamb and Other New Carols*, Lee Hastings Bristol, Jr.
Bristol provided copies to THS for mailing with the April 1951 issue of *The Hymn*. The Society imprint was included, but Bristol retained the copyright.
- 1952 *Representative American Hymns of the Twentieth Century*
Compiled to celebrate the thirtieth anniversary of THS.
- 1956 “A New Hymn on the Home,” Harry Emerson Fosdick
“O God, who to a loyal home” was used in observances of National Family Week under the auspices of the Division of Christian Education of the National Council of Churches.
- 1963 *Hymns of the Twentieth Century*
Seventeen hymns sung on the May 5, 1963, telecast by the American Broadcasting Company.
- 1965 *My God Is There, Controlling and Other Hymns and Poems*, William Watkins Reid
Sixty-five texts selected by a committee of THS and paid for by an anonymous donor.
- 1970 *The Hymns of Frank Mason North*
Nine texts without music, together with “Frank Mason North—An Appreciation” by William Watkins Reid (reprinted from *The Hymn*, April 1950) and “With Minstrel Heart” (modified from Creighton Lacy’s *Frank Mason North, His Social and Ecumenical Mission*, 1967). Paid for by an unidentified contributor.
