Course Description: Rather than limiting ourselves to false dichotomies, participants will explore a "streams" model that examines seven distinct traditions that flow through and shape our worship. Each participant will identify the primary streams in their congregation and develop practical strategies for broadening their community's sung faith.

Methodology: Each session will include a chapter from the course text, supplementary readings (optional), and YouTube performance examples. Each session will begin with an orientation to the stream, an update since the book's publication date (2013), and an analysis of selected examples in each stream. Participants will be invited to discuss each stream's relevance to their own ecclesial tradition. Drawing on Congregational Music Studies, a discussion of musical style and congregational performance will be included.
